ITEM #25, DOMESTIC WATER TREATMENT AND FILTERING EQUIPMENT: A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated waster piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed, and the installation complies with the applicable code. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the reponsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #25 (see item 3) for \$5.00 each, and the appropriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.

ITEM #26, MEDICAL GAS SYSTEMS shall include the application fee, one Special/Safety Inspection-Medical Gas System #26 (see item #21), and the estimated number of additional inspections in #22.

IX. Instructions For Completing Application

General: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with Montmorency County. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Plumbing Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. The telephone number for the inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection call the inspector providing 24 hour notice. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF PREVIOUS INSPECTION.**
